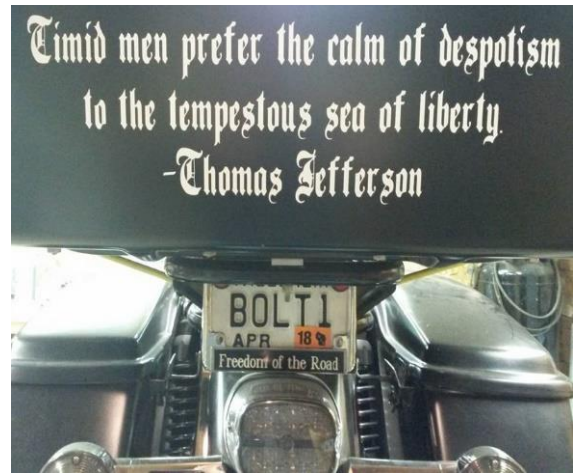

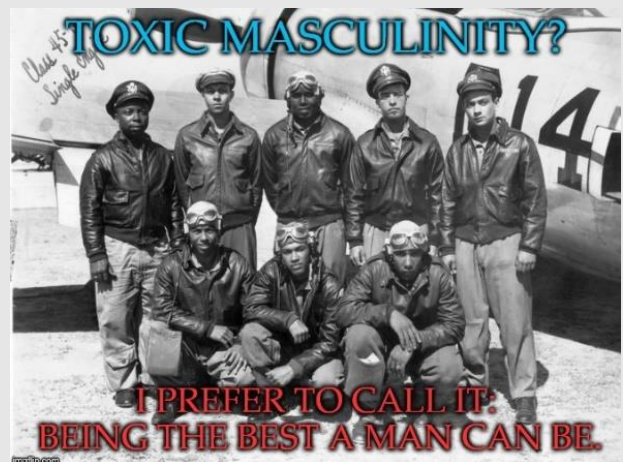

Immigration - Second Amendment - United States Sovereignty – Education
